

**Departing from Cleveland Airspace:**

Cleveland Hopkins has four Departure Procedures (DPs):

- ALPHE ONE (RNAV) [ **North / Northwest** ]
- AMRST ONE [ **West / Northwest** ]
- OBRLN ONE [ **South / Southwest / West** ]
- SANDUSKY ONE [ **North / Northwest** ]

Five preferred initial waypoints if NO DP is filed is not in your direction of flight.

- Sandusky VOR (SKY) [**West / Northwest**]
- Akron VOR (ACO) [**East / Southeast**]
- Mansfield VOR (MFD) [**West / Northwest**]
- FAILS intersection [**East / Northeast**]
- HERAK intersection [**South / Southwest**]

It is preferred that you have one of the above DP's or Initial waypoints as your initial fix. If you are unable please make that known to the Controller on initial contact.

**One exception to the above is the route from KCLE to KDTW.**

"DJB.GEMNI2" Max cruise for jets is 12,000', and 11,000' for turboprops (props with speed greater than 210kts),
